„Young Demographers“ is a newly founded research group within the German Association of Demography (DGD e.V.). The aim of the research group is to encourage scientific presentations of doctoral students and postdoctoral fellows as well as the support of national and international collaboration in the interdisciplinary field of demography. The intention of the research group's name is not to mark any age restriction for its research participants. It rather conveys the promotion of new ideas, research questions and methodological approaches in the academic discipline of demography.

The overall topic of the DGD-annual conference 2008 in Stuttgart will be “The implementation of the consequences of demographic ageing at regional level”. Nonetheless, the research group intends to organize a session themed „**Open Stage for Young Demographers**“ – a thematically open forum for the presentation of recent research. The session aims to be interdisciplinary and international. Empirical and theoretical submissions from the disciplines of demography, sociology, statistics, economics, and political sciences are welcome.

Abstracts should be submitted to the organizers before November 15 2007. They should not exceed two pages and contain the authors' contact information. Acceptance decisions will be communicated till mid-December 2007. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.
